THE ROLE OF THE INTERNATIONAL WOMEN PARLIAMENT

The United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) are a set of 17 goals that were adopted by the United Nations in 2015 as a blueprint for creating a more sustainable and equitable world by 2030. One of the SDGs that has a particularly strong focus on women is SDG 5: Gender Equality.

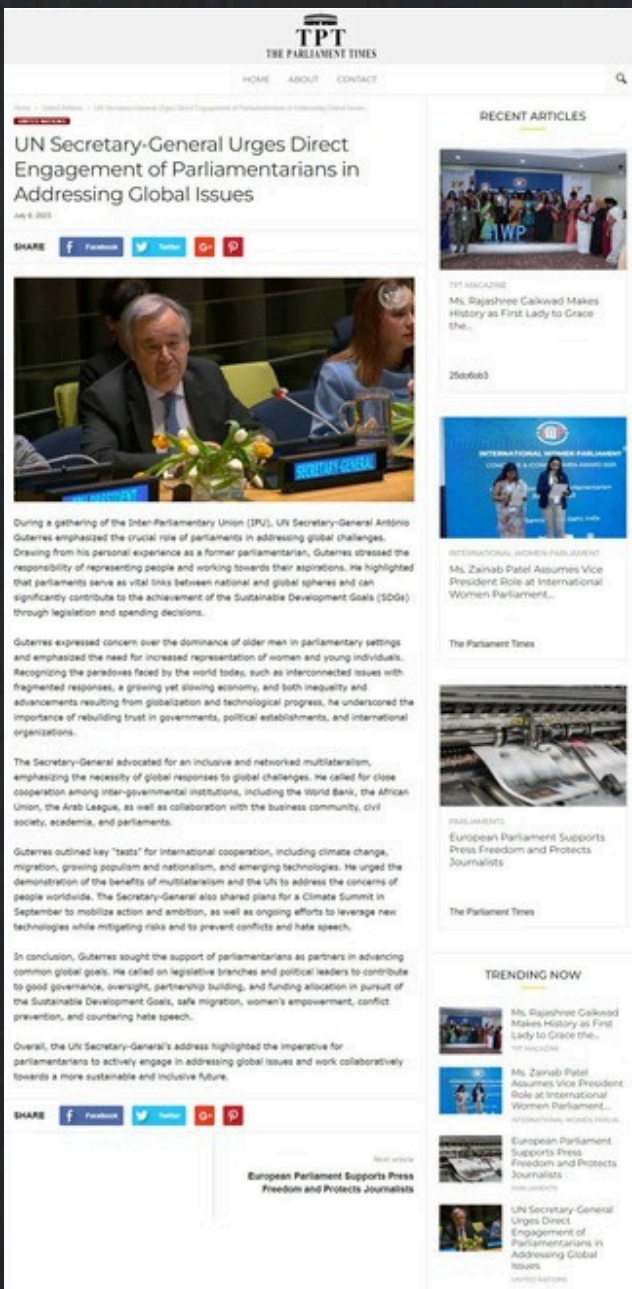


THE ROLE OF THE INTERNATIONAL WOMEN PARLIAMENT

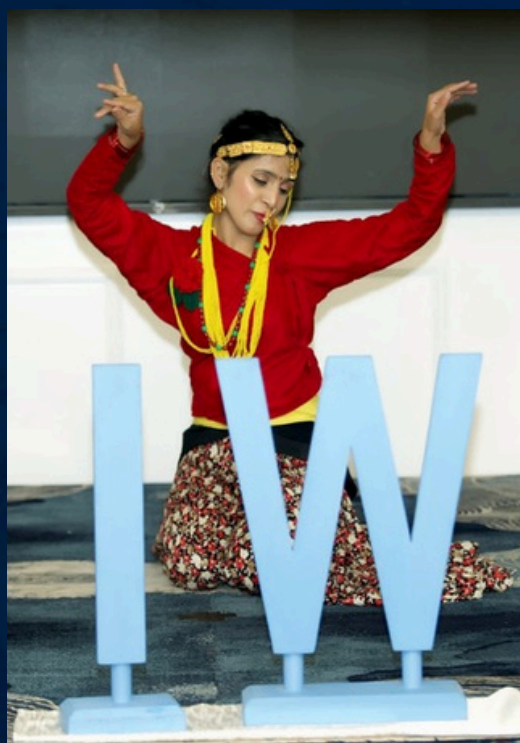
